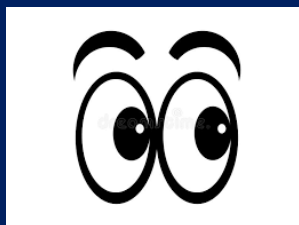


## Stewardship

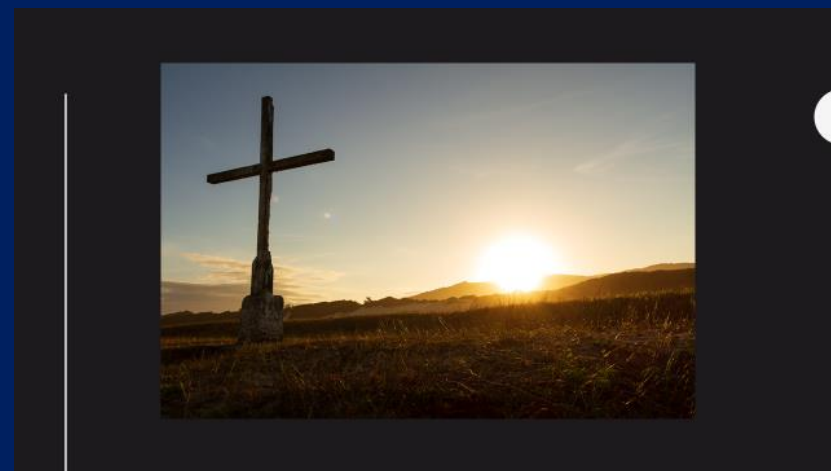
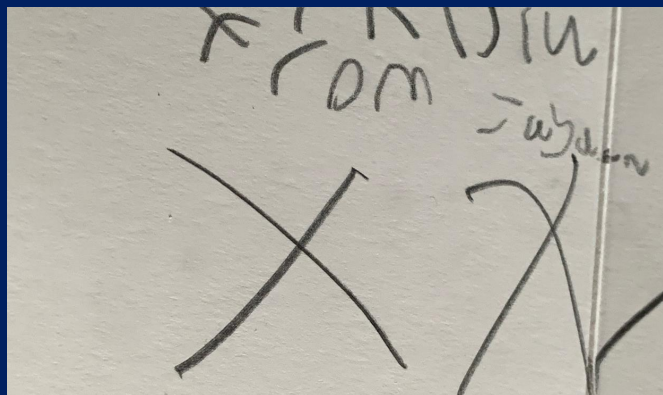

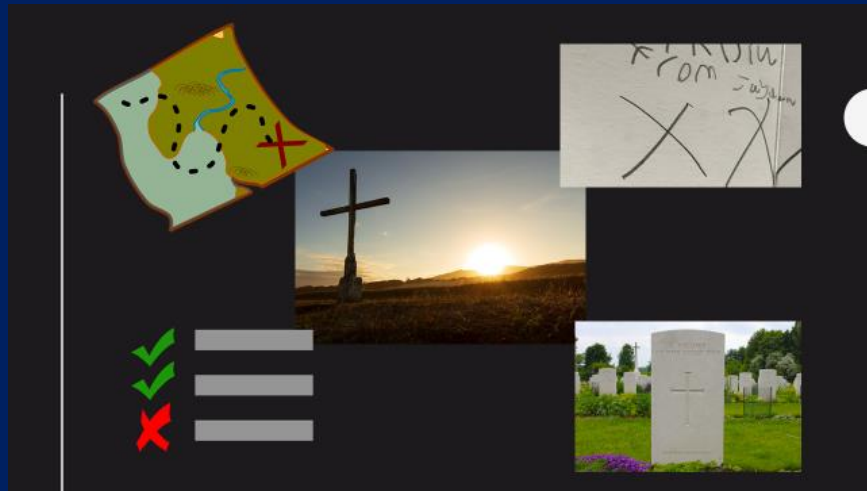


Look at these different crosses.
