- Build positive relationships with school, sharing information, and be proud of my child(ren)'s successes and achievements, big and small.

COURAGE

As families we will:

- Share with school any issues or concerns which may impact on the wellbeing, behaviour or progress of my child(ren).
- Support and encourage my child(ren) in completing any homework, helping them to be independent and to do things for themselves first, no matter how reluctant they are!
- Spend time understanding my child(ren) and their potential, encouraging them to work hard and to not to give up when things feel challenging.

DIGNITY

As families we will:

- Treat staff with care and respect in any dealings with them, be patient and calm when raising concerns with school, and have reasonable expectations when making requests.
- Treat other school families with care and respect.
