



### New Phonics and Spelling Rules

When we are counting, we pronounce consonants at the end of the numbers: **six, sept, huit, dix**. However, when these numbers become determiners introducing a noun, their final consonant becomes silent eg **six pulls, huit chapeaux, dix tee-shirts**. When we add an **s** or **x** to make a plural eg **un pull / trois pulls; un chapeau / des chapeaux**, we cannot hear the **s** or **x**: they are silent. **Sept** is an exception: **sept chapeaux**. (We still pronounce the **t**). We also pronounce the final **t** in **tee-shirt** as it comes from English.



We can make a **plural form** by using the **determiner** 'des' = some and adding 's' or occasionally 'x'




