At Altrincham C.E Aided Primary School we value the important role that staff, pupils, and parents play in ensuring that we keep everybody safe at this time

We ask parents to use this **COVID** -19 *Working in Partnership agreement* to talk to their children about how we can all work in partnership to implement health and safety measures which will minimise the spread of the virus.

At Altrincham CE Primary School we demonstrate the following values:









### Our commitments as staff of Altrincham C.E. Primary School As a member of staff I will do my best to:

- Provide an environment in accordance with the actions detailed in the whole school risk assessment in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can and limit contact within a 'bubble';
- Provide a curriculum that balances your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents and carers if your child displays symptoms their temperature will be checked if your child feels unwell or presents as being unwell;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' shows symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;
- Continue to promote positive relationships by following our behaviour Policy with an emphasis on supporting the mental health and wellbeing of our children;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, text, email and the school website.

# Our commitments as parents of Altrincham C.E. Primary School

#### To help my child at school, I understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family. I will get my child tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child immediately:
- When dropping off my child and picking them up, I will use the designated location and will adhere to the 2metre social distancing rules. Only 1 parent will drop off or collect;
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly adhere to the school timings for my child;
- My child will not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school (other than a disposable packed lunch and a water bottle with enough water for the whole day);
- I will remind my child about social distancing rules;
- I will encourage my child to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will collect my child immediately if they cannot clean themselves sufficiently after a toileting accident;
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment. Make appointments via telephone or the admin email address;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an environment which is 'as safe as possible' during the pandemic;
- Read all emails, texts and letters sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers emergency contact details.
- I will ensure my child wears clean clothes every day, these should be washed before being re-worn.

## Our commitments as pupils of Altrincham C.E. Primary School

#### <u>As a pupil I will do my best to:</u>

- Follow the social distancing rules in class, in the corridor and outside on the playground or field;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Not bring things in from home or take things from school other than a disposable packed lunch and a water bottle;
- Only use the equipment provided to me by the school;
- Not mix with any other children that are not in my group 'bubble';
- Only enter and leave the school building from the gate or door that has been chosen for my 'bubble';
- Follow good hygiene: coughing and sneezing into an elbow or tissue (catch it – bin it – kill it);
- Follow good hand hygiene use soap and warm water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;
- Make good choices and listen carefully to staff at all times for the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations, knowing that if I don't I will be sent home and will not be able to return to school until I am safe.
