

Curriculum Newsletter: Autumn 2 - 2022

Dear Parents and Carers,
Welcome back! We hope you had a lovely break and had lots of rest! We are looking forward to a jam packed half term of very exciting learning. In this table is a detailed explanation of all the learning which will take place in Autumn 2.

<p>English</p> <p>Key Text: How to be a sports star- Paul mason</p>  <p>Our second topic will be non-fiction writing - we will be diving into a new key text 'How to be a sports star', exploring our non-fiction factual writing abilities. We will be looking into a sport of our choice and creating a non-fiction book all about the key information you need to become a sports star.</p> <p>Have you got what it takes to be a Sports Star? Find out what it takes to be an amazing athlete. Learn how to cope with early mornings, competition nerves and how to defeat the chimp!</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>White Rose maths units this half term focuses on addition and subtraction falling into multiplication and division.</p> <p>As well as this topic we will also be continuing with our times tables practice.</p> 	
<p>History</p> <p>Our History question this half term is 'What do all civilisations have in common? How did the civilisation of Egypt wax and wane?'</p> <p>We will be placing the 4 civilisations onto a timeline, looking into why they set up on rivers. Also understanding what they did to a Pharaoh's body to prepare then for burial, compare and contrast the Egyptian hieroglyphics to Sumerian cuneiform script, look and compare some influential</p>	<p>Religious Education</p> <p>Our R.E. questions are - What do Jesus' parables tell people the Kingdom of God is like and what could He have meant when he taught about it?</p> <p>We will understand why Jesus taught about the kingdom of God and how he used parables, using some religious vocabulary used in the Bible. Which then leads us onto considering and reflecting what Jesus meant by the term "kingdom of God" in his parables.</p>	<p>Physical Education</p> <p>The children will be practicing dodge ball skills and participating in team games.</p>

Computing

We will be looking at computing creating media - specifically stop frame animation. We will use a range of techniques to create a stop frame animation using tablets.

Science

We will be learning about the human body. Children will be describing the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans and will be able to identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions. Then continue to identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

French

We have a weekly lesson, combining conversational French with some written work on grammar and vocabulary.
