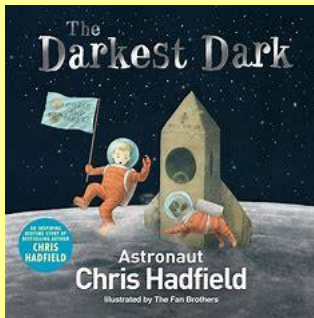


Curriculum Newsletter: Spring ii 2023

We will learn about more of the different biomes across the globe, including Savannah and Polar regions.



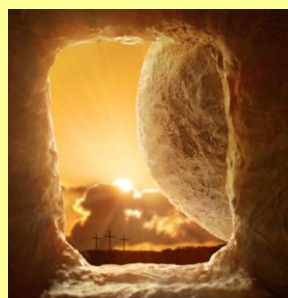
Maths

PE lessons will take place on a Wednesday, coached by Sale Sharks Rugby Club. Additionally, children will develop a range of team sport skills during COAL afternoons.



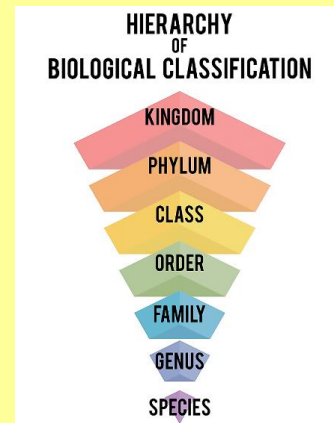
Computing

The next topic has a biology focus. We will be developing our understanding of classification systems.



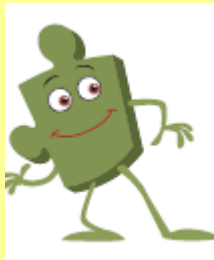
French
