10 Rules to Live By

Long ago God wanted to show his people how to behave towards one another and treat each other **justly**.

He gave Moses, who was the leader of the people, some special rules.

They became known as the **Ten Commandments**.

Hundreds of years after God gave these rules to Moses, Jesus was asked a challenging question by one of the religious leaders.

"Of all the commandments," he asked, "which is the most important?"

How would you have answered this question and what would have been your reasons?

The Ten Commandments

1. I am the Lord your God, don't have any other Gods apart from me.
2. Don't worship things that have been made, instead, worship the one who made them.
3. Think about how you speak about me; do not swear or use my name carelessly.
4. Remember the Sabbath and keep it special.
5. Respect your mother and father and listen to what they say.
6. Do not plot to kill anyone.
7. Be faithful to your husband or wife.
8. Do not steal.
9. Do not tell lies about other people.
10. Don't look greedily at the things that belong to other people.

Thank you for helping us to know the right way to live.

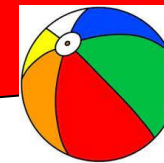
May your ways be our ways,
