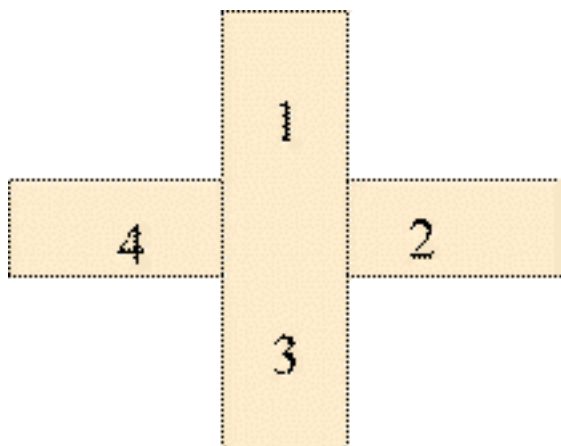


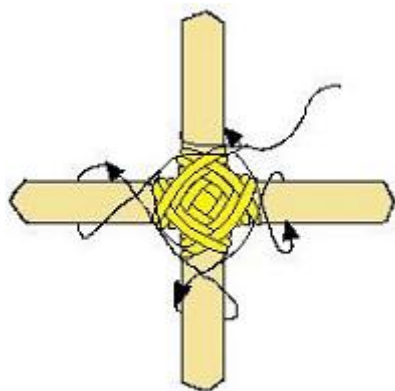
To make a Latin American Cross

Instructions:

- Glue the sticks together in the shape of a cross and let dry.



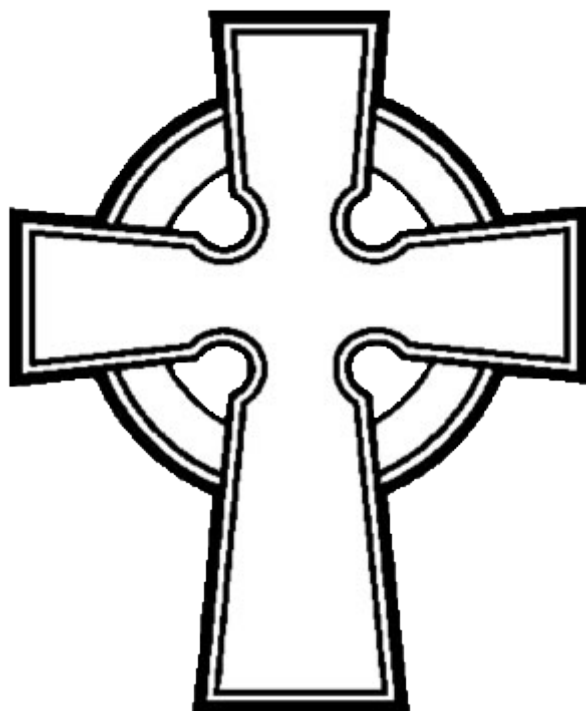
- always going in the same order around the sticks (you can mark the sticks with 1, 2, 3, 4 ... The numbers will be covered up in the end, but may make it easier to keep track of what you are doing).
- Wrap the wool once around 1, once around 2, once around 3, once around 4.
- Continue ... Once around 1, once around 2, etc until you're happy with the first layer of the eye.



Snip the first color of yarn and tie on a second color. Continue on with the second color and then a third, fourth and fifth as desired.

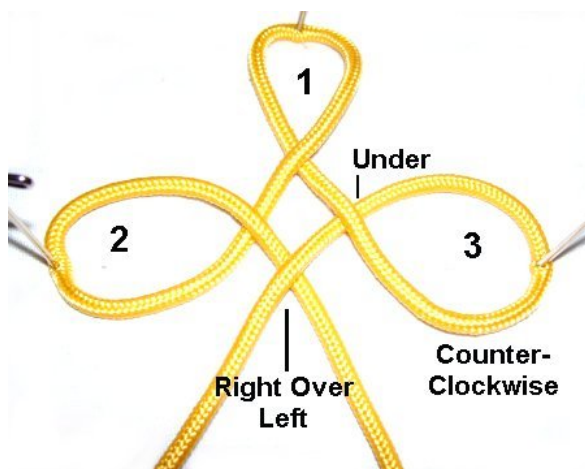
To make a Celtic Cross

Start with the basic template for the Celtic Cross.



Apply glue to the surface of the cross, then lay coloured string on the surface and weave it in intersecting patterns.

To make a Palm Cross

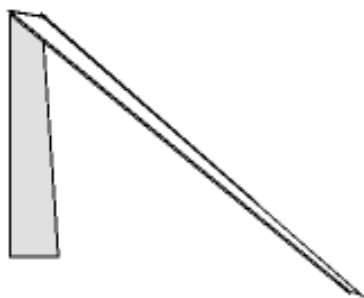
Use a 60-70 cm length of palm leaf, or card

Step 1

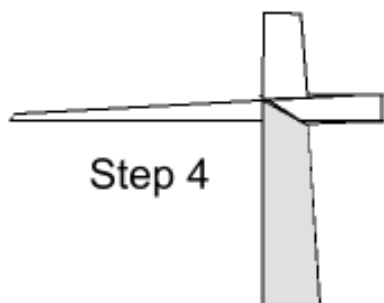
Fold the palm leaf down, about 5-6 inches from the bottom.



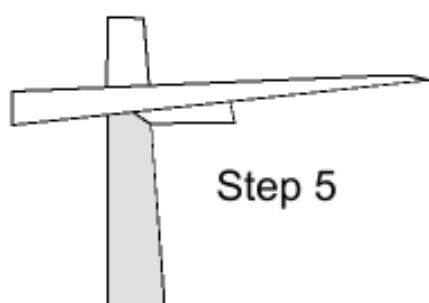

Tuck in the tapered end of the palm leaf and pull it through.

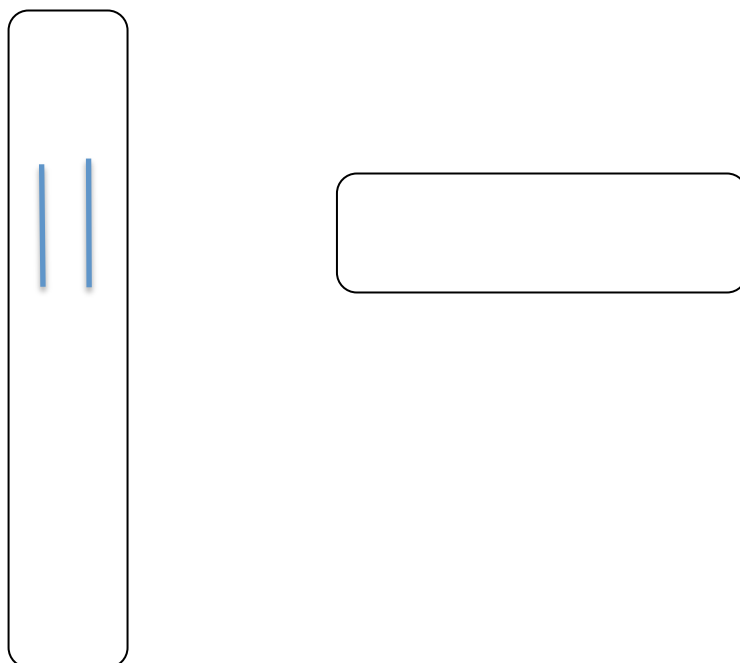

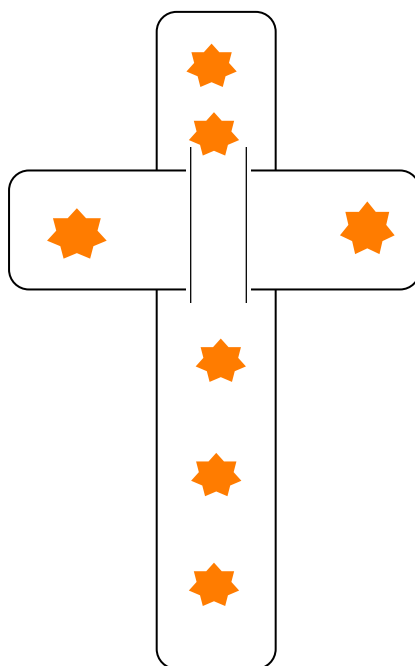
Turn the cross over. This is the front view.

To make a Bangladeshi Cross

Cut 2 strips of card to make the cross. On the vertical piece of the cross, tow thirds of the way up, cut 2 parallel slits through which to thread the cross piece.



Either sew on star shapes or stick gummed stars on the cross.



To make a Salvadorean Cross

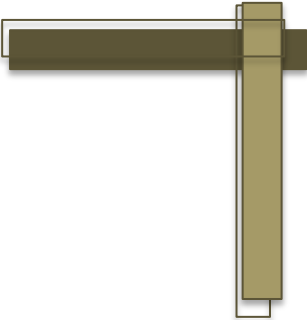
Design and paint a cross in a similar style to the Maria Gomez Cross. The illustrations could show some of the life of Jesus or could illustrate the story of your school community helping other people and each other.



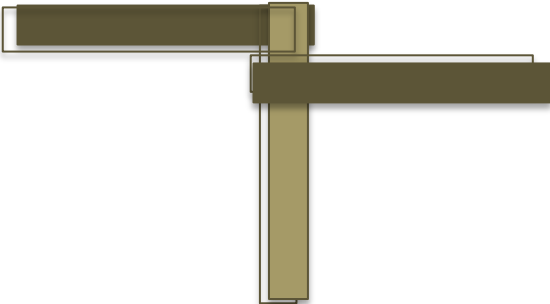
To make an Irish Cross

Use 4 pipe cleaners, or 4 strips of paper. Fold each in half. Then thread together, in three steps as below, before pulling tightly together.
