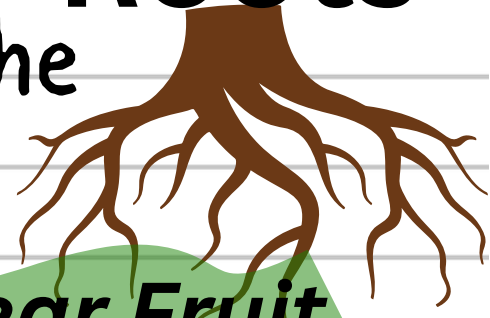

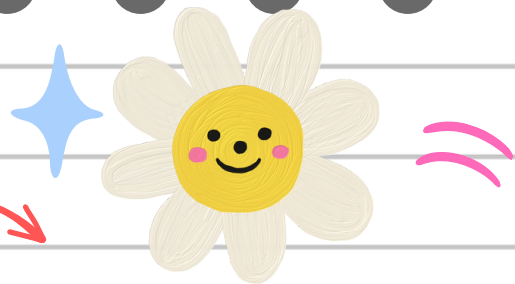
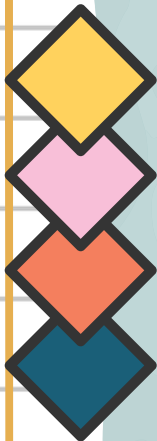
Let's Ponder...
