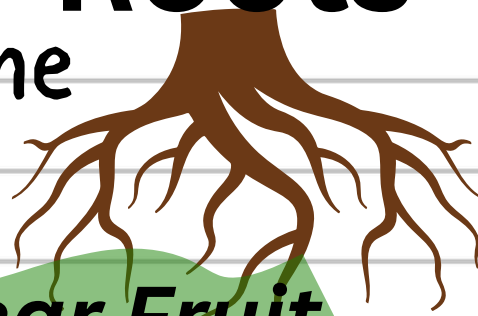


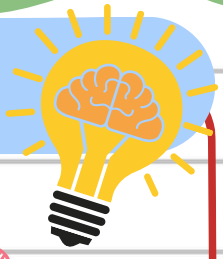

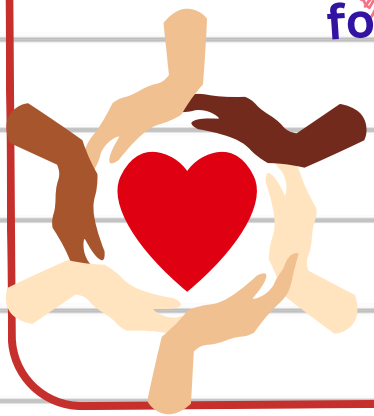

1 Peter 4:8

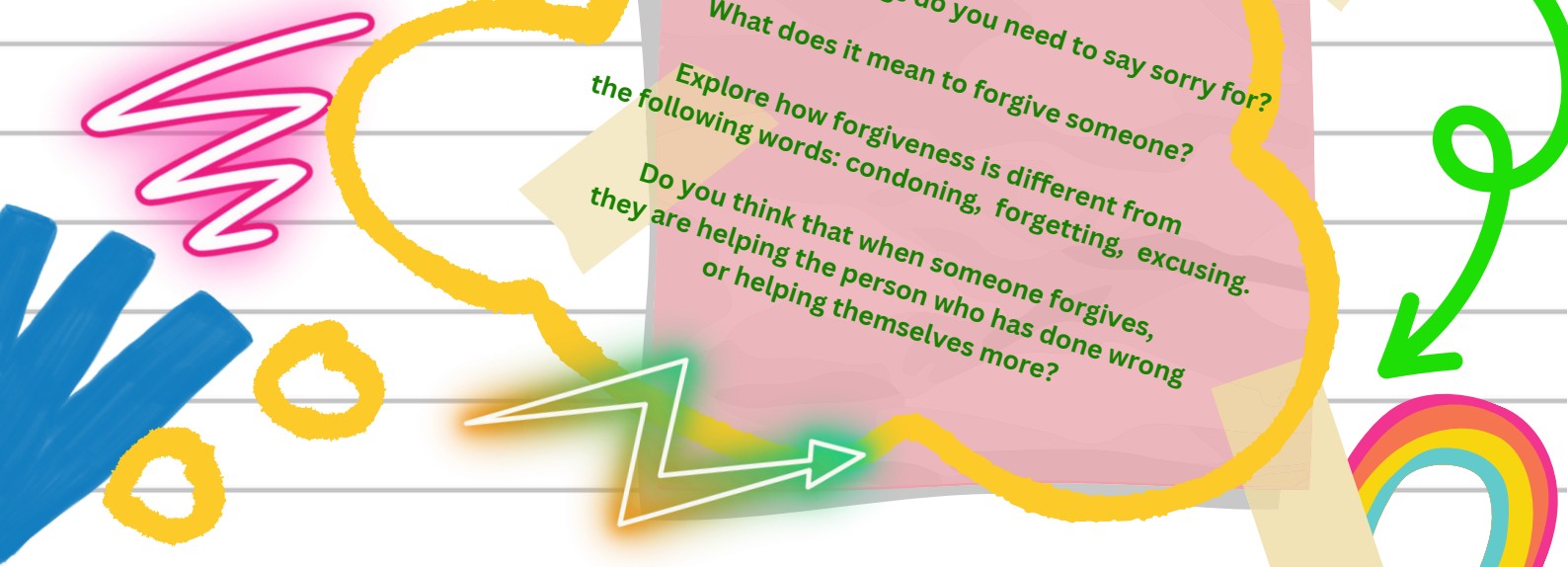
Let's Ponder...
