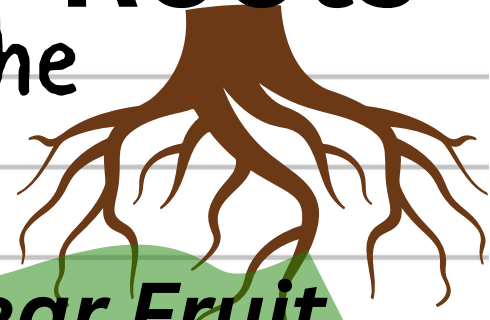




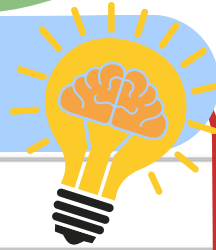

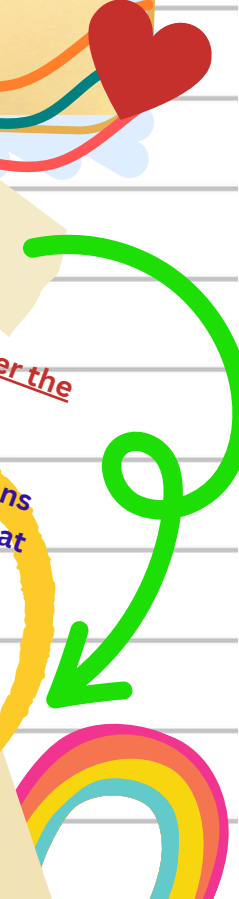
1 Peter 4-10

Things you can do at home this week:

AT HOME

Natural Wind Catchers

Giving thanks for the wonders of nature.

Go outside and collect as many natural objects as you can find at this time of year. See if you can find things such as pine cones, seeds, leaves, flowers, twigs, pebbles, shells etc. You will also need to collect one larger stick to hang your objects from. Using string, tie several objects along a piece of string, and then attach them to your main stick. Repeat the process until you have between several hanging pieces. Discuss with your friends and family the gifts of nature and give thanks for all that is provided for us. Look closely at the colours and the shapes, feel all the different textures of the objects you have chosen.
