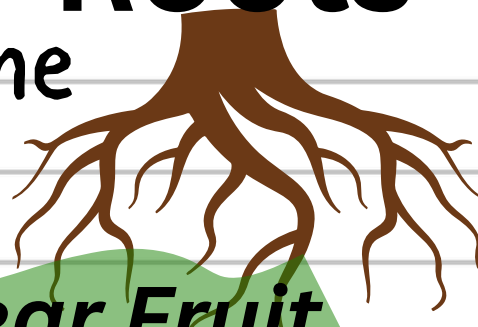


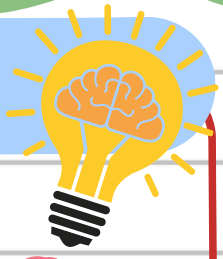

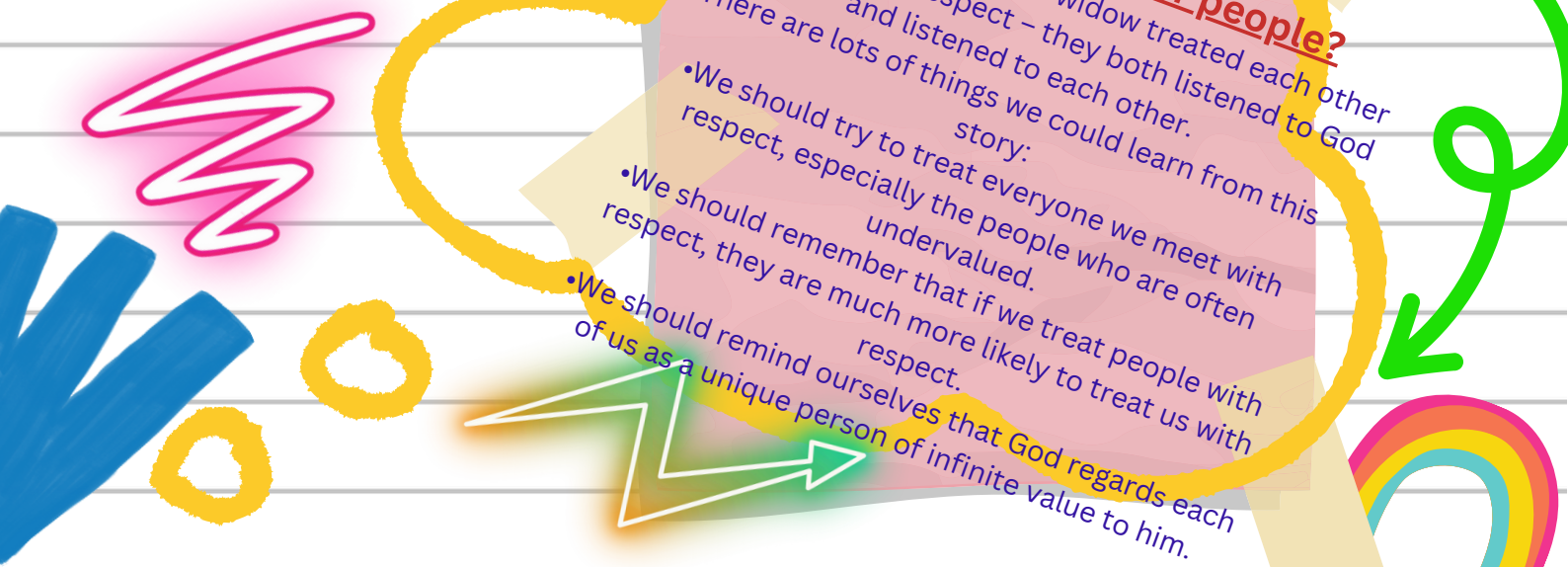

Friendship Butterflies



This activity is designed to celebrate friends and give thanks for our friends. Firstly, decorate a clothes peg: this will be the body of the butterfly. You can decorate it with felt tips or glitter the peg. Next put some sweets in a food bag and fold it in half, squeeze the middle so your decorated peg will clip on. The food bag with the sweets in will be the wings of your butterfly. Take a pipe cleaner and cut it into two pieces, these will be the antennae of your friendship butterfly. Once your butterfly is complete give it to one of your friends. When you give it to them, tell them all the qualities they have that make them a good friend. E.g. They listen to you, they share things, they make you laugh etc.
