Dear parents and carers,

Welcome back everyone. I hope you had a lovely Easter break and are ready for the new term. It is lovely to be back as Owls Class Teacher and I look forward to working with you and the children for the final term.

Details of our exciting curriculum for this half-term can be found below.

A few reminders:

- Children should wear PE kits on a **Tuesday. Wednesday** afternoon is COA and all children will be having Forest School this whole.
- School is a nut free school, this includes no nuts in lunch boxes (no hazelnut spreads) and sweets/chocolates brought in to share for birthdays.
- The school day is 8.50am to 3.20pm. The gates are locked at 9am and any late comers will need to report to reception. If any children have not been collected by 3.30pm they will be taken to the Arc after school club and charges may apply.
- Reading books, maths work and a piece of English work will be sent home each week.

English

The English Framework at ACE includes a daily session of Book Club. In addition to Book Club there will also be English lessons. This term we are continuing with the scheme 'Pathways to write'. The text for Y1 this half term is 'Toys in space' and for Y2 is 'The Last Wolf', both by Mini Grey



Maths

Year 1

We follow the White Rose Maths Scheme. We will be looking at multiplication and division followed by fractions. Then finishing off the half term doing position and direction.

Year 2

We follow the White Rose Maths Scheme. We will be looking at measurements of mass, volume and temperature and then moving onto fractions.



Religious Education

In our RE lessons we will be the Questful RE Scheme. Year 1 will be looking at the bible, specifically the Old Testament. Year 2 will be exploring 'The Church' and its meaning to Christians.



Science

Year 1 will be learning about plants and caring for the planet. Year 2 will be investigating plants, specifically bulbs and seeds and how they change over time. .



Computing

We will be following the Teach Computing units of
Y1 – Creating media- digital writing
Y2 – Creating media- digital music.



History

We will be asking 'Who was the bravest?' and will be looking at the lives of Rosa Parks, Martin Luther King Jr and Grace Darling.



COAL

Creative, outdoor and adventurous learning. These sessions will be on a Wednesday afternoon and it is Owls Class turn for Forest School



PE

Year 1 have PE sessions led by Sports Hub on a Wednesday and Year 2 have their PE sessions led by Sam Sheridan. Both coaches follow the PE Passport scheme and the children will be working on fundamental movement skills.



PSHE

We follow the Jigsaw scheme for PSHE. The theme for this half term is 'Relationships'.



Worship

Every week your child will be participating in whole school, Key Stage and class worship. This half term we will be doing lots of work around our new school mission 'Grow strong and bear fruit' and values of thankfulness, dignity, koinonia and courage.
