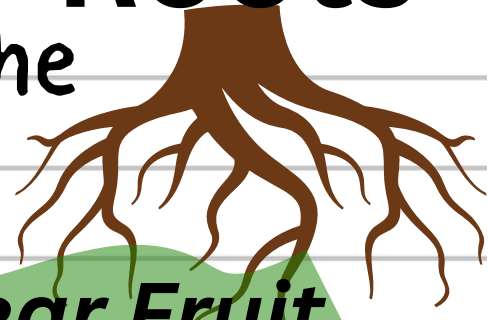


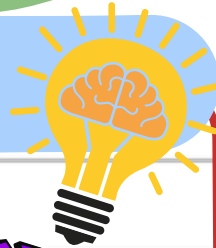

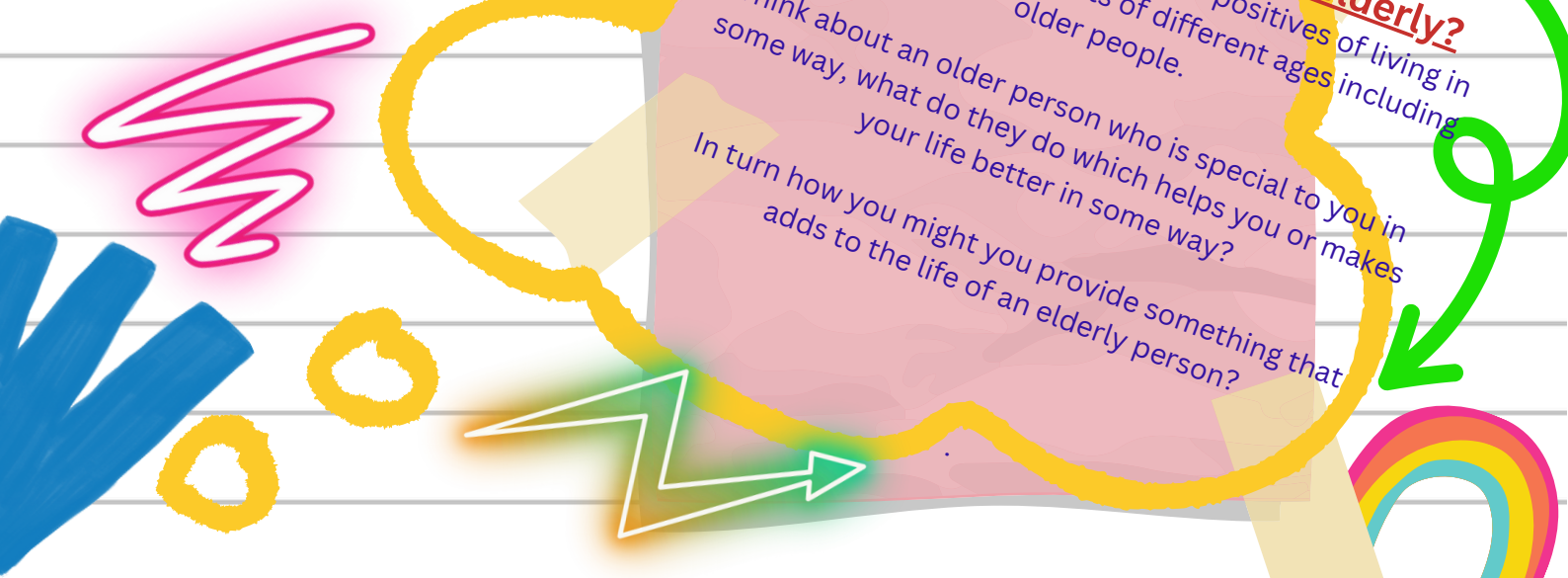


Let's Ponder...
