Go on a Spring walk. What signs of Spring can you see? Lambs, daffodils etc.	Choose a favourite animal and draw, paint, or make it using junk modelling (boxes, tubes, paper).	Count animals at home using toys, books, or pictures. Try putting animals into groups e.g. farm, wild, garden, pets etc	Make an Easter bonnet/hat	Play a movement game at home — move like different animals! Jump like a frog, slither like a snake, stomp like an elephant!
Baking challenge With a grown up, make an easter chocolate nest using rice crispies or cornflake cakes. Discuss how the chocolate melted.	How do some families get ready for Easter?
